# Summer Camp '22 Registration



Please note all children must be at least 5 years old as of May 31st in order to register! Children who have already entered the 6th grade, or who will be 12 prior to May 31st are not eligible to enroll.

# **SUMMER CAMP TUITION:**

**Tuition:** \$125/week/child. (3rd child is \$100/week)

Registration fee: \$60/child (up to \$120) for each new/returning child.

Activity fee: \$145/child

# **IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW!**

- Summer Camp registration is a contract. You are agreeing to pay to hold your child's spot, regardless of attendance, from May 30th until the last day of summer break (tbd based on the 22-23 RCSD/Pearl school calendar).
- Withdraw notices are not accepted during Summer Camp.\*
- Your balance is drafted every Monday. Our system drafts your CURRENT BALANCE. (including tuition, previous returned payments, NSF fees, etc. )

- A \$10 fee applies to stop a draft payment. An additional \$5 fee applies if balance is not paid by Monday at 6pm. Notice must be given by the Friday before. We cannot stop a draft the day of processing. (We reserve the right to refuse a stop draft request, or to run the draft on a future date if payment is not made.)
- A \$15 fee applies to returned/NSF drafts.
- Late Pick-up: Flat \$5 fee applies 6:01-6:05pm. Additional \$2/min applies after 6:05.
- Send a lunch every day!
  - No peanuts/peanut butter due to allergies.
  - -We CANNOT heat or refrigerate food!
- No outside belongings/toys/phones/electronics/blankets/pillows, etc. are allowed. We will not be responsible for lost or broken belongings.


## \*OUR FIELD TRIP POLICY IS STRICTLY ENFORCED WITH NO EXCEPTIONS!\*

The most polite phone call, rudest argument, threat of legal action, or threat of withdrawing your child does not change this! (So that we can focus on your child's experience here, and support our group leaders as they get everyone ready to go, we DO NOT "discuss" this policy during our prep time!)

To keep your child safe and prepared, and to make the day an enjoyable experience for everyone, **YOUR CHILD MUST BE SIGNED IN BY THE CUT-OFF TIME ON THE CALENDAR!**We have a field trip prep procedure that begins AT the cut-off time that STARTS with headcounts, finalizing group lists, and going over rules. (Your child will still have a blast with another group on-site!)

### **Medical Treatment**


Son Seekers, and it's employees, have my permission to obtain emergency medical treatment for my child, and make necessary decisions regarding all medical and dental attention that may become necessary while my child is enrolled. I furthermore will not hold Son Seekers or it's workers responsible for injuries or accidents that occur while enrolled. I will also not hold them responsible for reasonable and sound medical decisions they make regarding my child. I authorize the medical personnel to administer any emergency treatment deemed necessary, including the use of anesthesia. I understand that Son Seekers does not carry an accident/injury policy.

In case of an emergency and we are unable to reach any emergency contacts, your signature gives us permission to transfer your child by ambulance to the hospital named below. (Batson if left blank)



Plenty of advance notice will be given for any off-campus events/field trips. For Summer Camp, I have reviewed and approve of all field trips listed on the calendar, unless I give a written notice to a director to the contrary. I understand my child must be at the center by the designated time to go on field trips, or my child will be with the closest age group on site until their return. I know it is my responsibility to check the calendar and prepare accordingly. If we are late on a field trip day, I understand that it is my responsibility to act maturely and set an example for my child. I will not argue about the policy with staff or administration.

I also give my child permission to be transported to and from their school during the school year and as needed in an emergency relocation situation.

### Agreeing to support Son Seekers Procedures and Behavior Policy


I understand that before my child starts, I must read and review the parent handbook.

While enrolled, I am trusting the Son Seekers staff to care for my child, and should convey that sense of trust to my

child, in part by supporting their rules and consequences. I know there is always more to a story or situation than I realize, and that any concerns or uncertainties should be brought to a director in a private meeting with an open mind, where the situation will be discussed and the director will be able to take any appropriate actions to follow up or resolve the issue.



# **Bank Draft Information:**

Your account will be drafted as follows: \$125/child (\$100/3rd child) on May 31st, and approximately the next 9 Mondays (or first business day of the week) through 8/1. \*The final week of Summer will be prorated to the day if school begins midweek.

(Processing takes up to 24 hours. You may not see transactions appear on your account until Tuesday.) All charges will be billed to this account unless other arrangements are made with the site director to split billing. If you are currently splitting payments with another individual, you must talk to a director to split them for summer camp or all charges will default to this account.



The registration fee is \$60/child, up to \$120/family.

The activity fee (\$145) is charged to every child, and covers EVERYTHING.. field trips, on site events, t-shirt.. please DO NOT SEND MONEY WITH YOUR CHILD! We do not allow children to spend their own money. We keep everything simple and fair by covering everything!
