

Reservoir Summer Camp Parents,

We are so excited to have your child with us for Summer Camp 2022! We will be CLOSED Friday, May 27th for Summer staff development, and are excited to hit the ground running when Summer Camp starts Tuesday, May 31st!

Efficiency is key to your child having an enjoyable experience this summer!

We have strict policies in place to ensure our staff can focus their time and energy with their kids. Dealing with "small" issues such as missing lunches, wet clothes, broken/missing personal items, etc. take an unbelievable amount of time out of our day that we want to spend on activities with your child! We want to make you aware of these in advance so you can help us in our efforts to make this summer as enjoyable and stress-free as possible for everyone! The biggest "downside" to policies focused on efficiency is the consequences when these policies are not followed. PLEASE take the time to read this carefully. We want to play our part for your child, but we NEED you to play yours as well!

Drop-off & Pick-up:

All sites will be using an "in-person" check in/out procedure. Our parking lot is freshly striped with parking spots for the first day. The dropper-offer/picker-upper WILL USE THE LAST 4 OF THEIRRRR PHONE NUMBER on the tablet! We have already set up EVERY authorized person with THEIR OWN PIN!! For your child's safety, please wait in the building at check-out for your child. Children WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to walk out of the building unattended. If you/your picker-upper is physically unable to come in the building, please call the office and we'll be glad to help!

Field Trips:

We pay for everything! Please DO NOT send any money with your child! They will not be allowed to spend it!

Keep your calendar where you and your child can see it! Your calendar shows all the major events, both on-site and off-site. Your child must be dropped off by the EXACT TIME printed on the calendar in order to go on field trips. This includes prep and travel time. One bus chaser delays our departure time, changes headcounts that have already been called in, and often "can't hold it" on the bus ride because they missed the restroom break. They also miss the rules and directions we give prior to leaving about that day's trip.



When parents come in late with an "expecting to be the exception" attitude, children reflect that and become upset when they are walked to a different group. Likewise, they are quickly accepting of a "change of plans" when a parent is setting that same tone for them. Please don't ask to be "the one" that we break this policy for. It's an awkward situation for everyone, and ultimately upsetting to your child, when the staff and parent are not on the same page. This turns into an opportunity where a child learns responsibility and how to handle a situation maturely, or that throwing a fit long enough will get them their way.

Thank you in advance for agreeing to abide by this policy, to support the staff in this matter, and not putting your child in this situation. Any parent who would like to debate this policy will be given a copy of this letter and asked to set up a meeting at a later time. For your child's safety and enjoyable experience, parent conferences will not take place during field trip prep time.



Your child needs a sack lunch EVERY DAY! Lunches cannot be heated or refrigerated (reusable ice packs in lunch boxes work great!)

Lunch:

Please do not send peanuts or peanut butter due to severe allergies. Wowbutter and Sunbutter are great, peanut free alternatives (by the peanut butter at most stores)! It is near impossible to tell the difference, so PLEASE LABEL THE ZIPLOC OR USE THE SUPPLIED STICKERS on the label so we know it's not peanut butter!

•We will provide a 9am snack, and 3pm snack. We recommend your child eats breakfast before arriving.
•Water is provided throughout the day. However, you may send a labeled water bottle if you'd like.

Outside belongings, tous, electronics, etc.

We do not allow (and are not responsible for) outside toys, electronics, stuffed animals, pillows, blankets, etc.

•This also includes art supplies, journals, etc. These are the source of so much drama!

If your child is cold-natured, you may want to send a light jacket for them to use in the classroom, movie room, etc.

Accidents/change of clothes

We have extra clothes in the event your child has an accident, slips in mud, etc. However, you may send a change of clothes with your child if you would like. Please wash and return borrowed clothes as soon as possible. Shirts and shorts/pants that are not returned within 10 days will result in a \$10 charge. (Please do not return underwear.)

Please apply sunscreen before arrival on any days where outdoor activities are planned!
